


# TWIN 1.0 SCONCE

# **Installation Instructions**





# TWIN 1.0 SCONCE

Congratulations on your purchase of a SkLO Twin 1.0 Sconce. This product must be installed in accordance with the applicable codes by a person familiar with the construction and operation of the product and the hazards involved, preferably a licensed electrician. Use a maximum 7W bulb.


When unpacking individual items and parts of the light fixture, make sure to lay them out on a protective surface that will neither mar the delicate metal finishes nor scratch the glass. Gloves (nitrile) are provided and must be worn during installation to avoid fingerprints on the finish of the exposed metal parts.

## FOR WALL MOUNT ONLY

Your SkLO fixture will arrive with the hand-blown glass elements packed separately from the light fixture itself.




- It is strongly recommended that the Twin 1.0 Sconce only be installed in the vertical orientation as shown. This fixture does not provide an integral wiring compartment for making electrical connections – installation requires a recessed electrical box of minimum 103 mm diameter and maximum 120 mm diameter, with a minimum depth of 20 mm.
- 2. Carefully supporting the canopy, connect the exposed leads of the fixture to the exposed leads on the wall following the wiring diagram and using the provided wire connectors. Attach the ground (TE) wires to ground (TE) wires of the light fixture, phase 1 (L1) to phase 1 (L1) of the light fixture, neutral (N) to neutral (N) of the light fixture (Figure 1). Please note the number and type of wire connectors may vary.
- 3. The canopy installs directly to the pre-drilled holes with inserted anchors (not provided) that are appropriate to the wall material. Align the canopy all the way flush to the wall taking care that no electrical cables or connections are exposed where the canopy meets the wall. Fasten the canopy to the wall by screwing the two provided screws through the countersunk holes provided in the canopy, making sure that the canopy sits flush against the wall finish surface (Figure 2). Take great care when installing screws so that tools do not slip and scratch the canopy finish, or damage the exposed screw head slots.


- 4. Attach the provided thumbscrews to the stand-offs on both sides of the canopy. Do not tighten the screws yet (Figure 3).
- 5. Install the supplied LED light bulbs (7W Max) into the sockets (Figure 4). This fixture uses G9 sockets and light bulbs. The G9 is a bi-pin socket. Light bulbs are to be inserted and removed by pushing the bulb straight into the socket, and by pulling it straight out. The bulb, when inserted, should have a tight fit. Do not force the bulb. If there is resistance, check to make sure nothing inside the socket is bent or obstructing the bulb. Always turn off the power to the fixture when changing the bulb(s).
- Unwrap and lay out the glass diffuser. Carefully
  fit the glass diffuser over light bulbs so that it
  fits flush against the brass canopy surface. To
  secure the glass in place insert the crossbar
  into the stand-offs and tighten both
  thumbscrews (Figure 5).




