

SkLO Care Instructions – Glass

GLASS

SkLO handblown glass should be cleaned only with a soft, lint-free, or microfiber cloth using lukewarm water and a small amount of mild liquid dishwashing detergent, followed by a rinse with clean lukewarm water. Dry with a lint-free or microfiber cloth to prevent spots.

Wash only with lukewarm water – never expose handblown glass to extreme temperatures, either hot or cold.

Do not wash the handblown glass in the dishwasher.

Dust with a soft, dry cloth as needed. Canned air can be used to remove dust from unreachable areas.

MIRRORED GLASS

There are two different techniques used to produce a mirror effect on SkLO mirrored glass products, and each technique has different requirements for its care needs.

The two techniques have been grouped here by product – please find your product name below to determine the correct technique and corresponding care instructions

MIRROR PLATED GLASS

Light & Object products:

Reflect pendant

Wrap pendant (silver)

Wrap Pin 1.09 & Wrap Pin 1.21 pendant (silver)

Large Wrap object (silver)

Fingerprints or other marks and contaminants must be cleaned immediately to prevent the risk of damage to the mirror finish. Chemicals, cleaners, and abrasives will damage or remove the finish. Do not immerse in water. Clean only with a soft, lint-free, or microfiber cloth – use lukewarm water and a small amount of mild liquid dishwashing detergent only if necessary. Dry immediately with a lint-free or microfiber towel to prevent spots. Wash only with lukewarm water – never expose handblown glass to extreme temperatures, either hot or cold.

Do not wash in the dishwasher.

TRADITIONALLY MIRRORED GLASS

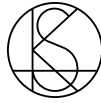
Object products:

Echo vessel

These SkLO handblown glass pieces have been mirrored using the traditional mirroring techniques which involve the application of liquid mirroring solutions to the interior of the glass form (the mirroring solution does not contain mercury). A protective lacquer is layered over the extremely delicate mirror, but the mirrored area is still extremely fragile, and should not be touched or wiped or cleaned.

Cleaning of the outside of the glass can be accomplished by following the general care instructions for glass, but great care must be taken to avoid touching the inside mirrored surfaces with bare hands. Do not scrub or clean the mirrored surfaces with any sort of liquid or cleaner.

Do not immerse in water.



SkLO Care Instructions – Metal

DARK OXIDIZED STEEL

Object & Light products:

Object table stands, wall hooks, and sculpture armatures

Lasso 48/60/72 Chandeliers

Dust with a soft, dry cloth. Wash only with a clean, damp cloth, and dry with a lint-free cloth.

Do not immerse in water.

POLISHED NICKEL & BRUSHED NICKEL PLATED FINISHES

Object table stands, wall hooks, and sculpture armatures

Clean only with a soft, lint-free cloth. Do not use chemicals, cleaners, or abrasives.

DARK OXIDIZED BRASS

All SkLO dark oxidized solid brass light fixtures have a hand-applied wax finish.

To maintain and preserve the patina, clean only by wiping with a lint-free, dry cloth.

ANTIQUE BRASS & BRUSHED BRASS

Object table stands, wall hooks, and sculpture armatures

Our antique brass and brushed brass finishes are “living” finishes. The brass is not polished or lacquered. These metal finishes have a hand-applied wax finish. Over time, the brass is intended to darken naturally. Clean with a soft, lint-free cloth. Do not use cleaners or abrasives.

SkLO Care Instructions – Stone

MARBLE

Light & Furniture products:

Rest Pendants

Join Tables

Dust with a soft, dry cloth as needed. Do not use abrasive or acidic cleaners. Acids will cause etching of the marble surface – clean any acidic liquid spills from the marble surface immediately with a soft cloth and water and a mild soap, such as dish soap, if necessary.
